5) Syllabus:

This course will focus on cultural tourism in Poland and Central-Eastern Europe. Topics of lectures include:

Cultural tourism development – genesis, evolution and new trends.

Traditional and modern forms of cultural tourism – case studies.

Cultural heritage and recreational physical activity – case studies.

Cultural heritage sites and trails in Poland and Central-Eastern Europe.

Dark tourism sites: dealing with the difficult past.

Post-socialist heritage in tourism – the case of Nowa Huta district (Krakow).

Promotion of cultural tourism destinations. Heritage interpretation.

- 6) Students will learn about traditional and modern forms of cultural tourism. They will focus on case studies in Poland and Central-Eastern Europe, including post-socialist heritage and dark tourism sites. They will acquire basic knowledge about heritage interpretation and promotion of cultural tourism destinations.
