Types of ecotouristic activities practised in Poland-e.g. birdwatching, botanical excursions, geoturism. Case study: mountain biosphere reserve.

Outdoor classes: forms of ecotourism in selected national park.

7. Effects of education:

a/Knowledge – student:

- has basic knowledge about sustainable tourism and understands essential terms;
- has essential knowledge about ecotourism as an important branch of tourism business in Poland.

- has the ability to present orally his/her own opinions and projects. He/she can speak on professional issues in ecotourism using proper terminology;
