- 1. Subject: Theory and Teaching Methodology of Volleyball
- 2. **Type of course:** classes (practical training)
- 3. Form of assessment: class attendance and class participation (no examination)

- 6. **Syllabus** studies of 1st degrees, physical education, semester 4th (summer)

Purpose of teaching: knowledge and abilities essential for instructing for on different levels of education and in sports clubs. Instructing and perfecting of technique of volleyball, interpretation of regulation of game (judging), the basics of game tactic.

Matters required before proceeding to the course: acquaintance of character of game and basic regulations, methods and principles of instructing of techniques of movements.

Skills required before proceeding to the course: ability of execution of basic-special motor action (ball handling, relocation).
