

1. **Subject:** Active tourism
2. **Type of course:** class contact, outdoor classes
3. **Completion form:** credit with mark

5. **The number of classes:** 20 hours (class contact –10 h, field exercises 10 h)
6. **Syllabus:** Definition of active tourism and qualified tourism; characterization of active tourists and qualified tourists; main types of active tourism practiced in Poland in the light of natural conditions; lowland hiking; hillwalking; cross-country skiing; down-hill skiing; ski-touring; cycling and mountain biking; canoeing; sailing; environmental impact of active tourism; Polish and international NGOs' involved in active tourism, safety principles in active tourism, personnel in active tourism, guiding.
